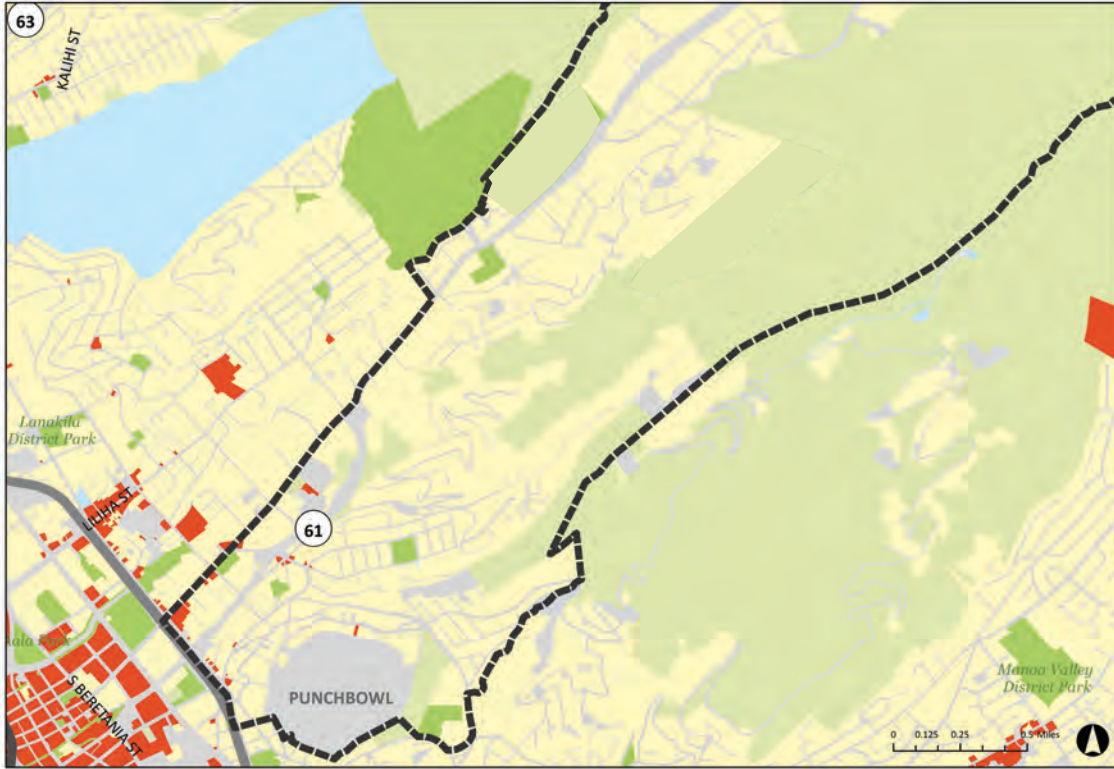

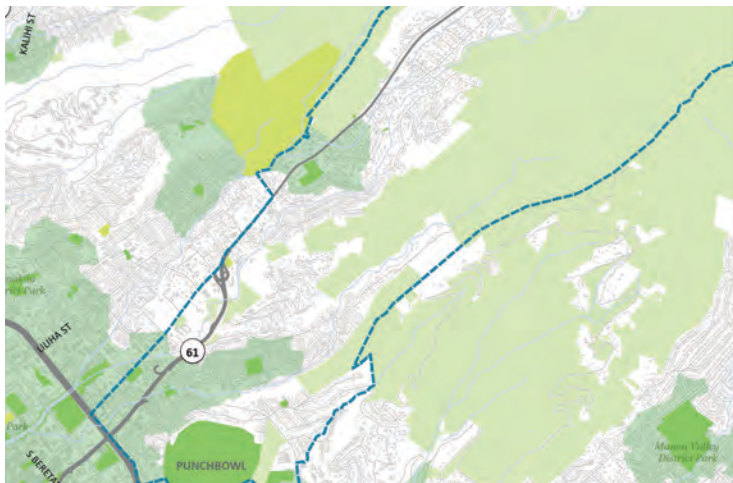

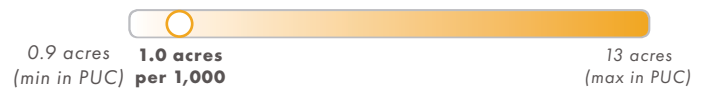

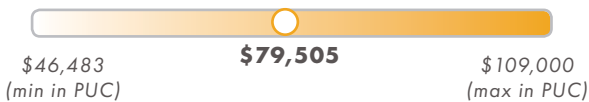

MEDIAN GROSS RENT



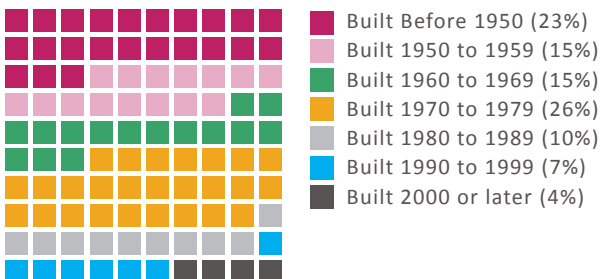

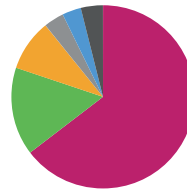

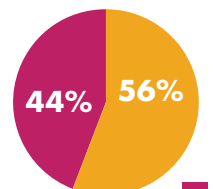

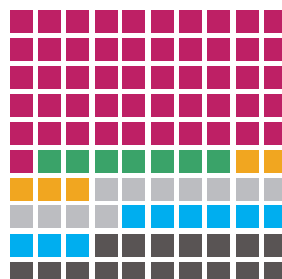

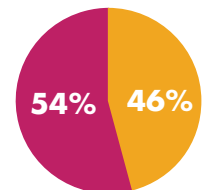
